# Montcalm Stage Band releases first album

Spring is in the air — and swing is in the air as well. May 10 marked the completion date for a very special project of Montcalm's Stage Band: The release of their first album.

"The CD was released on Monday," says Francois-Olivier Fortin, the group's bandleader, enthusiastically.

Fortin, a saxophonist who's studied at the University of Montreal and moved to Sherbrooke to teach, has been working with the Montcalm Stage Band for quite some time.

"This is my fifth year of doing stage band for Montcalm," Fortin says. The group, composed entirely of students from Montcalm School, does the band as an extracurricular activity. "It's very, very part-time work, one practice a week," Fortin says.

Over the last year, the band's been active, participating in several events, all of it culminating in the release of their own CD.

"The group participated in a jazz fest at the end of March," Fortin says. "They have put in a lot of work over the year."

All of this practice put them in the position to record their album in a 'natural' environment, bereft of recording trickery.

"The CD was recorded on the 10th of April at the Centre Des Arts in Richmond. It was a live recording, with no cuts or breaks," Fortin explains. "We recorded the pieces from start to finish. There were two microphones. The sound is just the musicians and the room. There's no excessive production, no tricks."

The band's a great way for music students at Montcalm to become involved in the music world, not only in the large band but also in splinter outfits.

"The stage band has twenty to twenty-five members, and there are combos of seven or eight people," Fortin says. All the groups take their turns on the disc.

500 CDs have been pressed, and if you want one, they're not that hard to find. "They're being sold by the students, the teachers, and at Archambault for \$15," Fortin says.

One thing that makes this disc special, according to Fortin, is the amount of local talent that went into its creation. The CD features guest appearances, local arrangers and songwriters, and special talent behind the scenes.

"There were many musicians involved in the project," Fortin says. "Kevin O'Sullivan, for instance, helped

with the percussion, coaching and assisting."

Other local jazz luminaries and guests appear as well.

"There were two invited soloists. Louis Belanger played guitar — there is no guitar at the school — and Jean-Francois Marquis on cello," Fortin says.

"Two pieces were arranged by Gilles Dion, including You'd Be So Nice To Come Home To. He's a local musician who plays the trombone and has his own Dixie ensemble, New Orleans Jazz Express."

Fortin himself has six arrangements on the album, as well as an original composition, Shuffle Madness. One composition was written by a student, Joseph Arseneault. The Little Green Man With The Trumpet, a blues-influenced duet that ends the album.

Fortin hopes the CDs will sell well and the groups plan to use any profits to

buy new musical instruments for the school.

"We're looking at some congas," he laughs.

Those wanting to see the group live will also get their chance, as they will be playing in Sherbrooke's upcoming Festival des Harmonies.

# Bonneville: 'Life's a road, not a destination'

Supremely poised, vivacious, intelligent, and blessed with a real sense of generosity, Ray Bonneville continues to walk his own path. This is what soon comes across when I sit with the singer/songwriter in a restaurant for this interview.

There's no requirement for frills or red carpet treatment with Bonneville. The guy is humble and candid when he answers questions. Honesty is a beautiful quality and you immediately recognise it in Bonneville.

He has just released a third album titled *Gust of Wind* which showcase his ability and wit as a songwriter and instrumentalist while his whiskey-soaked voice does wonders with this beautiful collection which doesn't suffer from overproduction.

"A record is like a snapshot. It's a snapshot of where you are, how you feel and what your life is all about at that time" says Bonneville. "As soon as you've done it, you're already moving on, so you can't hope for something that's gonna stay with you and always be current."

His first two albums, *The Main* and *Solid Ground* were about love bad or good, relationship between a man and a woman, anger and broken hearts. But songwriting, like human beings, evolves.

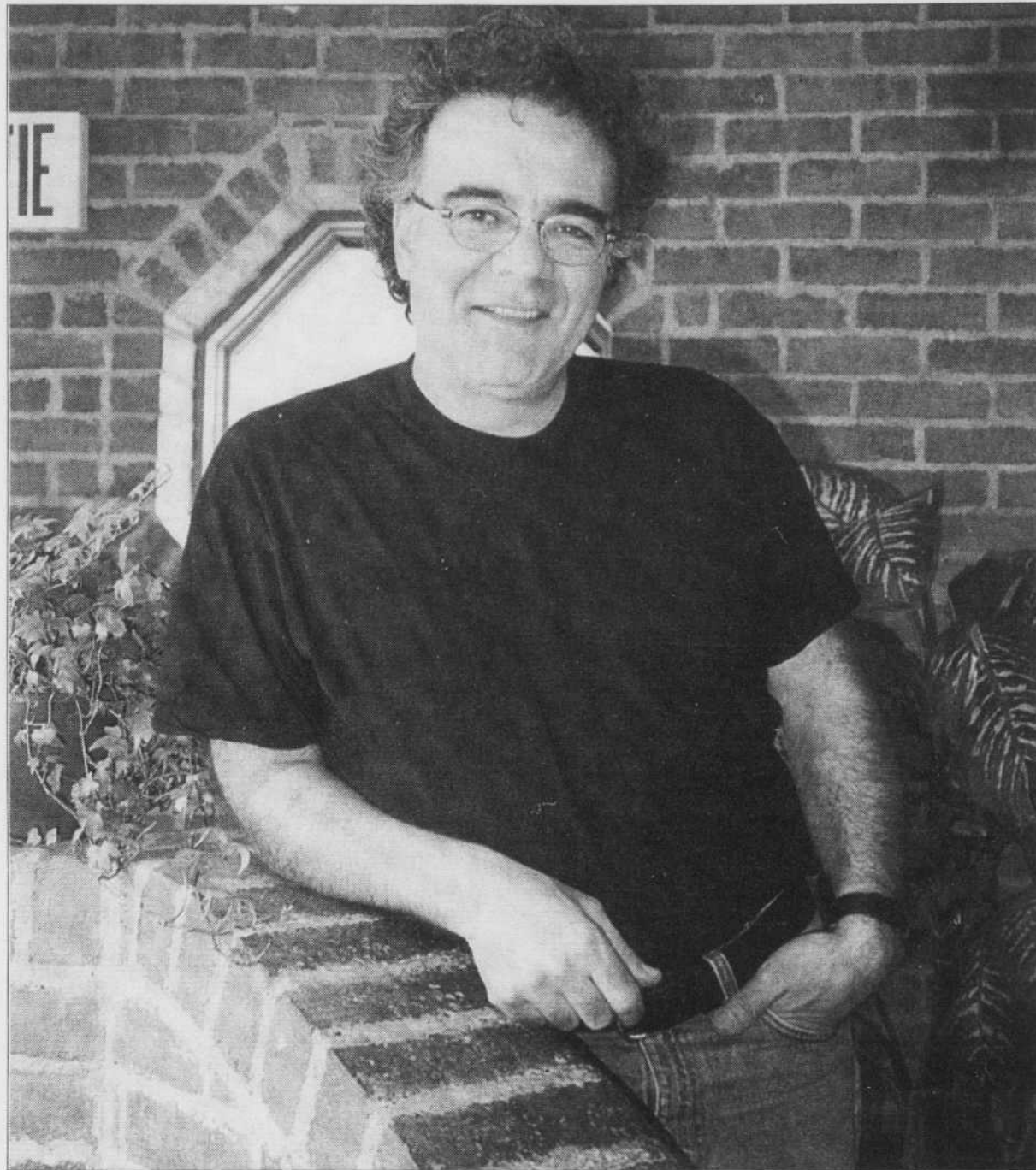
"This time around the album is wider, it's about the human being and getting along with other people, paying attention to what's going on around you. It describes people and situations familiar to everybody. I've grown up and my songwriting has grown up" he says self-assuredly.

But Bonneville's focus on the understanding of music and lyrics is great: what he writes is easy to absorb; there's a subtlety in what he does that makes it easy to relate to.

"People put on records and they don't always pay strict attention to the record. They're doing other things: having dinner, cooking, driving their car. They're going about their lives. So I like to make my songs easy on the listener. It's a subtle thing, not easy to do because it's a great temptation to want to put more. Anyway the songs take me somewhere, I don't take the songs somewhere" he says about his songwriting.

The guy is a storyteller but the stories aren't always about himself. Most of the time they're about something he has observed. The album was recorded in three different cities: Montreal, Toronto and Nashville as Bonneville explains.

"If you're in a different place the feelings are not the same, for example if

you're in Nashville or in the South anywhere, the pace is slower the climate is warmer. You've got different surroundings and food. It's funny how this all sneaks in your music. It changes my head space, keeps me off guard, fresh and creative" says Bonneville.

The singer who has been regarded as a Bluesman up until now doesn't agree that record companies and radio stations need to put a label on artists and this is something he resists.

"You can't describe music with a single word. I consider myself a singer-songwriter influenced by Blues, Country, Cajun, as well as by my surroundings so all this will reflect in my music" he stresses.

Bonneville's music appeals to a multitude of people because of all the differ-

ent influences you find in the melodies and lyrics. The Montreal-based singer is a riveting performer with an easy-listening style and songs that stick to your brain and soul.

*Gust of Wind* will also be released in Europe soon but on a different label and this is exciting for the singer who has lived in Paris for a year. It's a beautiful city, charming for its architecture and the history that's there but he's happy living in Quebec. Of course the musician has travelled quite a bit from the time he was born in Gatineau, where he lived for twelve years.

His father being transferred in Boston brought him to the United States where he spent the next 27 years before he came back to Quebec. With his dual citizenship, Bonneville came to see himself

as a North American and this suits him fine.

After his teens, he headed South and decided he would be a professional musician and that singing, playing harmonica and guitar would be his life. He paid his dues and 30 years of performance earned him stage appearances with Blues legends such as B.B. King, Muddy Waters, Sonny Terry, and Brownie McGhee.

He's played festivals from Monterey to New Orleans, as well as in Europe. He's spent hours developing a guitar style and gut-felt harmonica lines. He loves music and music loves him.

For now he's touring Quebec to promote the new album. He will perform in Montreal, Quebec City, Gaspé, and Sherbrooke. He'll be performing at Le Cafe du Vieux Clocher in Magog on May 21, 22, then, he'll head for Ottawa and Toronto.

Summer festivals are also some

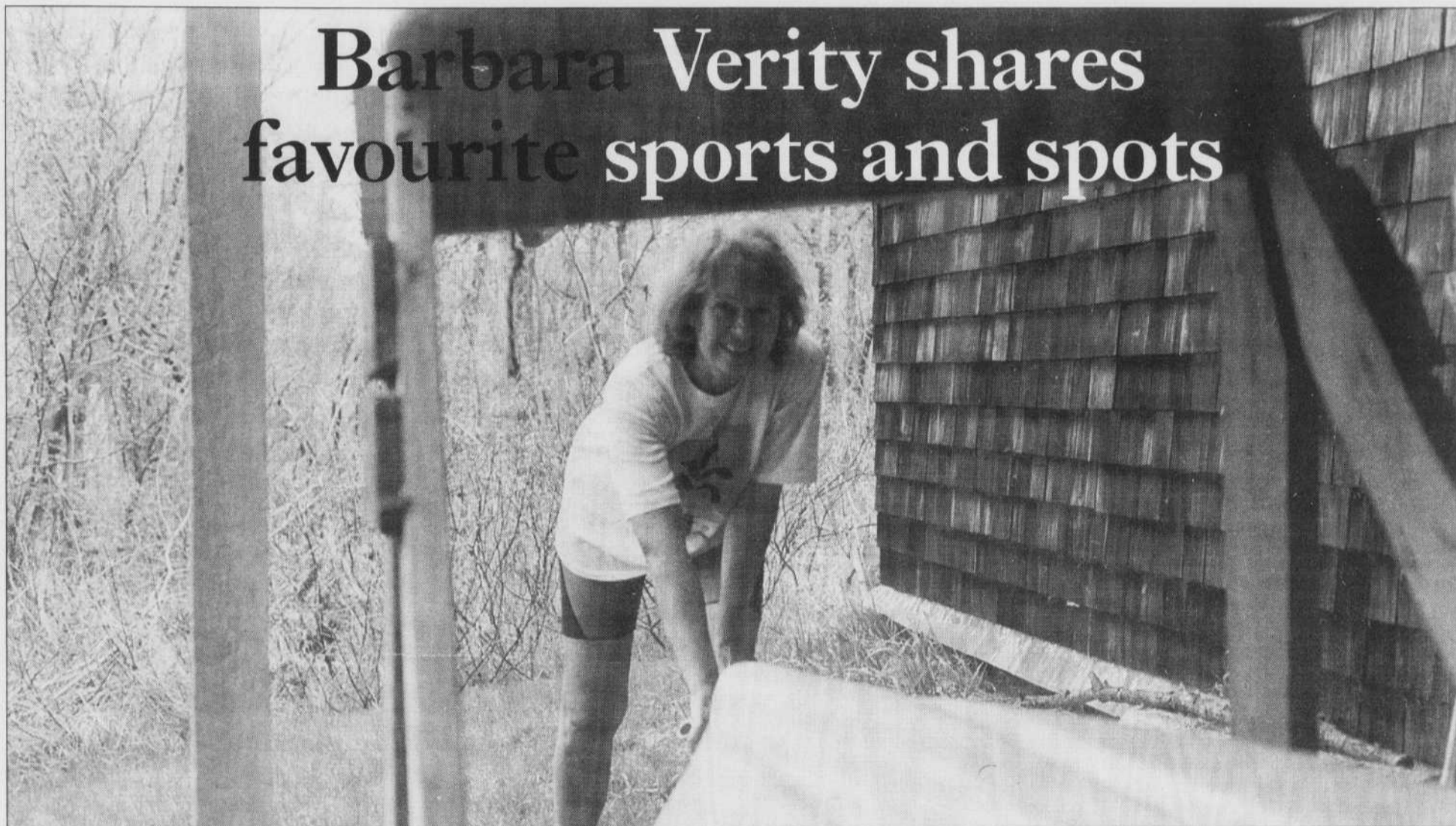
of his destinations before he leaves for Europe. The man is busy but enjoys every single minute of it. His life's philosophy is rather special and he's not about to stop.

"One thing I'm sure of in life is that I can't be sure of nothing. Life's a road not a destination, I don't want to get where I'm going otherwise I'd have to stop" he says with humour.

Fans know they have to see the show. As for the others, Bonneville is a musician well worth discovering as he's got much to offer. According to him, in music you're never at the end of your learning cycle.

You can see him perform solo at Le Cafe du Vieux Clocher in Magog Friday and Saturday May 21-22. It is better to make reservations.

# Barbara Verity shares favourite sports and spots

## New book will keep outdoor enthusiasts On The Move

It's a common summer complaint among old and young alike: "There's nothing to do around here."

Not so, says Barbara Verity.

For Verity, the author of the new book *On The Move: An Outdoor Guide to the Eastern Townships*, enjoying the vast natural bounty of the Townships is easier than most people think.

"This is a book aimed at the ordinary person," Verity says. "Outdoor fanatics would get something out of it too, but it's aimed at ordinary walking, cycling, hiking, and flatwater canoeing and kayaking."

She is in a position to know, having been a presence on the Townships travel scene for years. She is also the author of *35 Places to Cross-Country Ski in the Townships*, released a few years ago, and has been writing nature and low-key travel articles for the *Montreal Gazette*, *Stanstead Journal* and *Townships Sun* for years.

She has been working on the book "intensively for about two years," she says. "I did draw on files that I've kept on hiking and provincial parks, which made it easier."

Her journalism experience was an asset too, the former *Record* editor said.

"It was a pleasure, a combination of doing what I like to do and a progression of my newspaper work."

The book is mostly based on first-hand experience.

"I've been on all of the bike excursions I've listed," she says, "Ninety per cent of the trails, all of the canoeing and kayaking. Of all the hiking I've listed, I've done about sixty per cent. Other information comes from friends and hiking clubs in the region."

The book, 244 pages long and retailing for \$22.95, contains hundreds of references to places to hike, cycle, backpack, camp, canoe, and generally get involved in the outdoors across the Townships.

Rather than suffer the delays and complications associated with finding a publisher, Verity decided to publish the book herself.

"I got a bank loan for the first book and got my money back. That paid for printing, design and translating. I haven't done a French version of this

book because of the huge translation that would be involved."

The book is a wholly Townships enterprise, having been printed at Blanchard Litho in Lennoxville and designed by son Scott Stevenson and Tim Doherty.

Verity has her preferences in outdoor activity and trails, as well.

"Cycling and kayaking are my favourite activities - cycling my favorite and kayaking a close second," she says. "From my point of view, I like to combine country roads and linear trails. Linear trails are too straight, too flat. My preference is for three-quarters country roads on a circular trip, so you're not retracing your steps. You can go through towns, see gardens and old houses. I also like the hills, both for the challenge and the view when you get to the top."

Now, she hopes her book will not only serve as an invaluable aid to tourists from outside the region, but also to help Townshippers explore the beauty around them.

"It's amazing, when you start looking, how much there is to do," she explains. "People go to stores and think there's nothing else. Over the years I've noticed a lack of this sort of book in the Townships. In Vermont, there are tons of books - I've even seen a guide to

fences! I wanted to do something in broader depth than you can with articles."

Verity also hopes that the book will help the casual trekker try some new things.

"I think a lot of the problem comes with not knowing what's out there," she says. "A tourist booklet put out by the province is good, but lacks detail. We all tend to have our favourite lake to paddle in, our favourite bike path ... it seems to be human nature. Friends that have gone on excursions with me were amazed with what we found."

The current environmental trend towards preserving nature by discouraging tourism doesn't faze Verity, either.

"The more you spread people out, the better off you are," she explains. "It's the density of people that does damage. If people go to a variety of places, we can absorb a lot of people."

She also hopes that her book, and a growing appreciation for the wild Townships, will help engender a spirit of preservation.

"The more the public values landscapes, the less they will pollute it," she says.

"I try to give people a sense of value and beauty so people feel responsible for keeping it that way."

## Cowboys who rock

Country with a touch of rock are this week's favorites. The word is out that Tracy Byrd is changing labels after six albums and many years with the MCA family. After a mutual agreement (no hard feelings) the singer and company executives came to the conclusion that they had both done about as much as they could do for each other.

MCA is the label behind big names such as Reba McEntire, George Strait, Vince Gill and Trisha Yearwood so it makes it hard for the company to bring the major attention needed by someone like Tracy Byrd at this stage of his career.

Byrd is happy with the success he's known so far but feels that it could be brought to a new level. So he switched to RCA records where label president Joe Galante is ready to give him all the latitude he needs to use 100 per cent of his God-given talent.

The "Watermelon Crawl" singer now has a new contract, new enthusiasm and a new album in the works and is ready to take his career to the major leagues. At the moment he's at the stage of selecting the songs and the first studio dates have been set for early June and in August he will finish the project.

Byrd will be teaming up with Billy Joe Walker Jr. to co-produce the new album, with more freedom to decide what he wants to do as a recording

artist. Fans hope he won't change too much since his style has brought him considerable success with country music fans so far.

Here's my pick of albums for the week:

### COUNTRY CONNECTION

**SAMMY KERSHAW: Maybe Not Tonight** (Mercury)

For the Louisiana native, *Maybe Not Tonight* is the eighth album and might feature the finest singing of his career. Half of this new collection is comprised of ballads which concentrate on matters of the heart while the other half is mid-tempo country rock with just a smidgen of sizzle.

The whole album has huge crossover potential and his crooning tenor voice renders his treatment a bit dramatic, but thoughtful. Kershaw never came across as an up-tempo singer but rather a romantic.

The album opens with the duet "Maybe Not Tonight," and the Lorrie Morgan/Sammy Kershaw collaboration works very well. The song is already finding a spot on the radio as well as on the country charts.

There's also the playful, light-hearted love declaration titled "Me and Maxine," to which a hint of fiddle was added for a reminiscent touch.

You find a lot of humour in the Tom Shapiro/Al Anderson-penned "Ouch," about a tough character whose only weakness is the woman who makes him feel like "putty in your hands,"

which is an awful feeling for a strong man.

The definite highlight on this album is another powerful ballad, "When You Love Someone," written by producer Keith Stegall and Dan Hill. Kershaw goes deep inside his soul in order to offer a convincing rendition. His interpretation is strong and emotional.

The album offers twelve songs and he has co-written three of them such as "Louisiana Hot Sauce," a mid tempo, funny love song along with "Love Me, Loving You" and "How Can I Say No."

He performs well on every single tune, but is outstanding on "Look What I Did To Us," a number about separation and abandonment.

Overall this is a pretty good album but I wonder if one day Sammy Kershaw will do something catchy enough to get intensive radio attention!

**MONTGOMERY GENTRY: Tattoos & Scars** (Columbia)

Montgomery Gentry is made up of Eddie Montgomery (John Michael's brother) and Troy Gentry, two young country newcomers with excellent voices and an attitude. What they do can be called country with an edge.

Their first single "Hillbilly Shoes," is heading for the Top 10 and Montgomery Gentry is taking more steps to stardom with a triumphant debut album that's selling like hot cakes.

"Hillbilly Shoes," is some kind of

tribute to good old boys with whiskey on their breath and free spirited hearts. It also indicates the influences that they grew up listening to such as Waylon and Willie, Merle Haggard, Skynyrd, Marshall Tucker band and of course Charlie Daniels who happens to play a part on the duo's album.

Daniels and a couple of his band members wrote "All Night Long," and he lends his vocals for the recording. The duo sounds convincing with their very sad rendition of "Lonely and Gone."

They can also be philosophical on the folksy "Trouble Is," which is about a long-gone lover while contemplating the things that happen in life on the quiet and thoughtful title track, "Tattoos & Scars."

There are a few rock sounds and they deliver a good message on "Daddy Won't Sell The Farm", while "Didn't Your Mama Tell Ya'," is intended to make you kick up your heels on the dance floor.

If you expect this record to sound like a John Michael Montgomery album because of the brotherly relation, you are mistaken since little brother has a style of their own.

This debut album is excellent and if their sophomore effort keeps the promises of the first I think they might have a nice place in mainstream country.

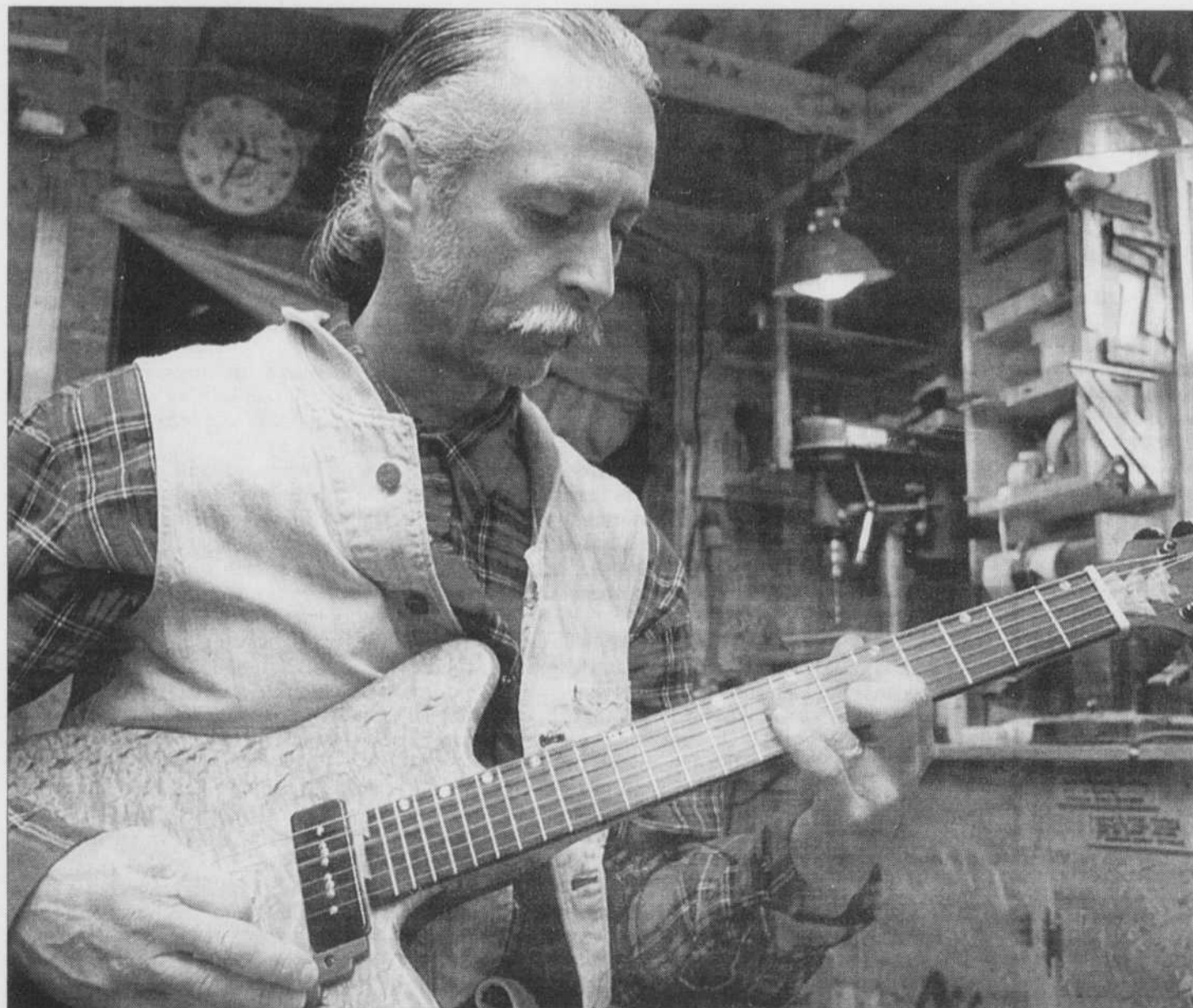

# Insights into a summer blockbuster

It wasn't just the computer-generated special effects that stretched the budget of *The Phantom Menace* to \$115-million US. When George Lucas cast Liam Neeson as Jedi Master Qui-Gon Jinn the budget had to be increased and it had nothing to do with the lanky Irishman's salary.

"We only ever built portions of each

set. The rest of the sets were added digitally in the computers after filming was completed," explains producer Rick McCallum.

"Originally the height of the sets was supposed to be 6 feet but because Liam is almost 6ft 5inches tall we had to increase the height of the sets."

Natalie Portman is happy to announce that she has a date for her prom. Portman, 17, who plays Queen Amidala, the mother of Luke Skywalker in *The Phantom Menace*, started

doing interviews for the film in February. "At that time, I really didn't have a date for my (college) prom. I thought it was an innocent remark but reading it now makes me sound so dorky." Though Portman would have no problems getting a ticket to the premier of *The Phantom Menace*, she won't be in a theatre on Wednesday.

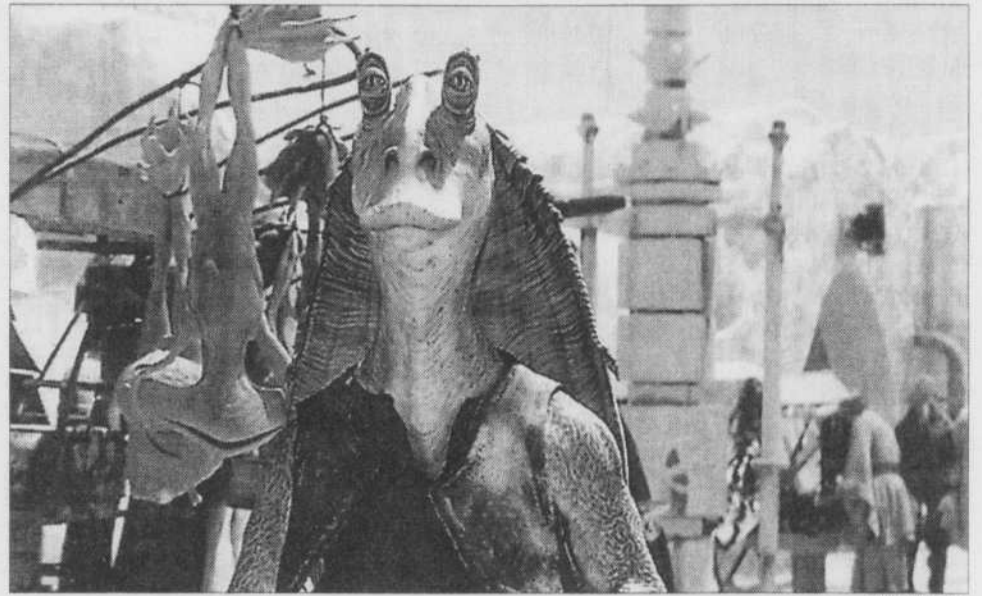
"I have my biology final the next day so I'll be at home cramming. I've seen the film but I do want to catch it with some of my friends but we'll probably wait until our finals are over."

Portman has heard the rumors that Dawson's Creek's James Van Der Beek was supposed to be her love interest in the next episode of the new Star Wars trilogy.

"I got to meet James because one of the other actresses in my next movie

Anywhere But Here was dating him at the time we were shooting the film.

"He's a great guy but I understand it's already been decided that he's too old to play the teenage Anakin Skywalker who be-

comes my lover in Episode II.

"I understand they're looking for an unknown actor and that certainly leaves James out."

The Star Wars franchise is not George Lucas' only concern but it is his priority for the next six years. After that, he'll return to another pet project, the Indiana Jones movies.

"We finished a script three years ago that George, (director) Steven Spielberg and Harrison Ford all like but we can't put it into production until these Star Wars films are completed," explains producer Rick McCallum.

The appealing thing about this particular Indiana Jones script is that it isn't age dependent on Harrison. He can play the character no matter how old he is when we get around to it."

McCallum adds "there was never any intention of doing the fourth Indiana Jones without Harrison. He is Indiana."

Swedish actress Pernilla August who plays Shimi Skywalker, grandmother of Luke Skywalker allowed her 14-year-old daughter to accompany her to Tunisia for the filming of her scenes in *The Phantom Menace*.

"It was my way of rewarding my daughter for a year of silence," explains August.

"When Rick McCallum called to tell me I had the role, he made me promise I wouldn't tell anyone until George Lucas made the formal announcement. "Of course I told my husband, oldest daughter and my mother but no one else. My daughter was only 12 at the time so it took a lot of restraint on her part."

August received her telephone call on a cell phone when she was shopping at a duty free shop in the San Francisco airport.

"I'd met George Lucas earlier that day. I never expected to hear anything for months. I was so excited, I purchased the

largest bottle of champagne I could find to celebrate with my husband when I returned to Sweden."

August is one of Sweden's most respected stage and film stars having worked with celebrated Swedish director Ingmar Bergman.

She admits it's quite a journey going from Bergman to Star Wars but adds "I'm not playing one of the creatures or Jedi. I think George wanted me to bring some dramatic weight to the early scenes of the film. I'm 40 years old. This can only be a major to my career."

Rick Park who plays the villainous Darth Maul in *Phantom Menace* was originally hired as a stunt double for the character.

"Rick is an amazing gymnast and martial artist and he's an expert with all kinds of Asian weaponry," explains McCallum.

"He was helping us choreograph the major fight sequences when George realized we weren't going to find anyone better to play the role."

Park has been studying martial arts since he was seven and has been a member of the British martial arts team for the past eight years.

He was a stunt double on the film *Mortal Kombat 2: Annihilation*. He has already completed a role in Tim Burton's *Sleepy Hollow*.

Darth Maul has a special two-sided lightsaber. Liam Neeson recalls "it was breathtaking to watch Rick in action. It was as if he'd been born wielding that lightsaber."

Neeson and Ewan McGregor both had stunt doubles who "did most of the spectacular moves but Ewan and I did our share of saber fighting."

"Ewan insisted on trying to do a lot more than we were required to do but that's because he's younger and Scottish," jokes Neeson.

## Divine Divas

The supreme Supreme offers viewers a master class in star power in the TV-movie *Double Platinum*, airing Sunday, May 16, on ABC. Diana Ross and young singer-actress Brandy star as an estranged mother and daughter struggling to rebuild their relationship in the face of formidable odds. The movie opens in 1981, as Atlanta singer Olivia King (Ross) leaves her infant daughter and unsupportive husband (Tony nominee Brian Stokes Mitchell) to take a shot at a music career. After that short prologue, the movie zips to the present, in which a successful but guilt-ridden Olivia wants to reconcile with her daughter, Kayla (Brandy), who wants to be a singer herself. Moviegoers of a certain age will remember that Ross seemed on the verge of a major movie career in the early '70s with an Oscar-nominated turn in 1972 as Billie Holiday in *Lady Sings the Blues* and a strong follow-up in 1975 with the lesser musical romance *Mahogany*. Then came 1978's *The Wiz*, one of the ugliest and most ill-conceived musicals in film history - a train wreck of a movie that derailed Ross' acting career for years. The role of Olivia is by no means a great one, but Ross reaches deep to give the character far more complexity than is scripted, in a performance that is a wonder of relaxed authority. Brandy is very good, too, in a role that lets her cut her studied sweetness with a little tartness, even bitterness. And when both women launch into their solo numbers, as well as one duet, well, a reviewer pretty much just puts down his pen and luxuriates in the sound.

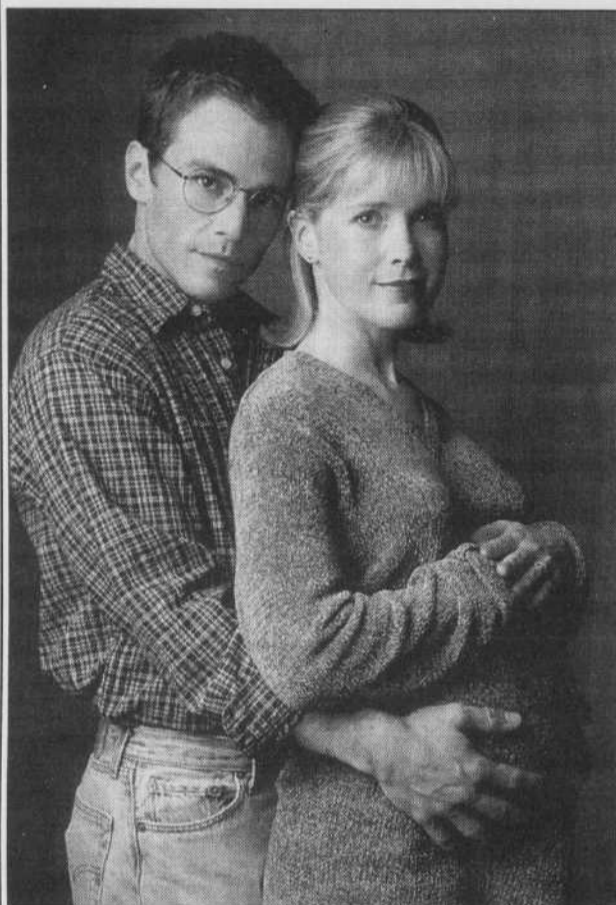

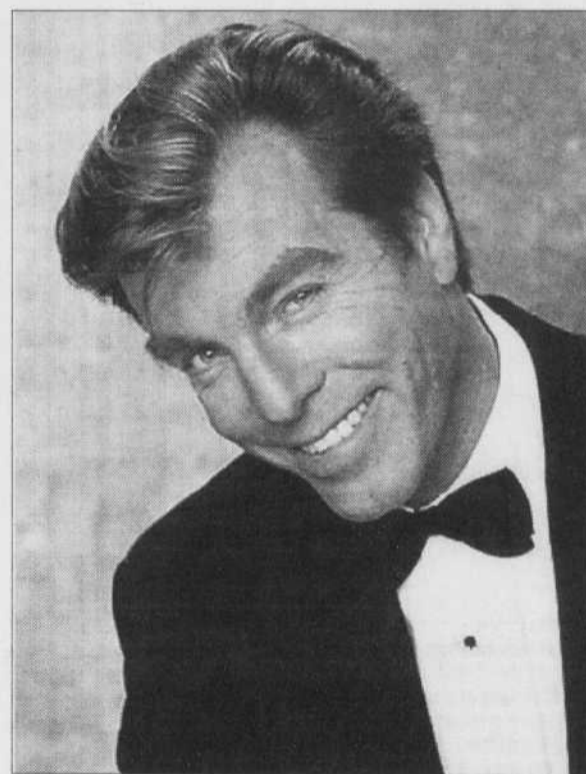

The 26th Annual Daytime Emmy Awards, airing next Friday, May 21, on CBS, honours the best daytime has to offer. Or at least that is what one would think. The truth is, there are always embarrassing omissions, and this year is no different. Linda Dano (Felicia, Another World) and Hillary B. Smith (Nora, One Life to Live) are among the actors whose outstanding performances were overlooked. Emmy winner Peter Bergman (Jack, The Young and the Restless, pictured) says the problem stems from the nomination process. "An actor nominates himself or the show can do it," says Bergman. "Lists are compiled of everyone who was sent in, and then the list is mailed to every actor in a contract role in daytime. The actors select who will be a nominee from this master list." Unfortunately, people who work in daytime seldom get to see their peers in action. The nominees then send in tapes of their work, which are viewed by blue ribbon panels comprised of people who work in the industry. These panels pick the Emmy winners. "I've been on those panels and I can tell you the tape is everything," says Bergman. "This may be the first time the people sitting in the room have ever seen the actor. Someone who has had a killer year may be passed over for an actor who has a more dramatic tape."

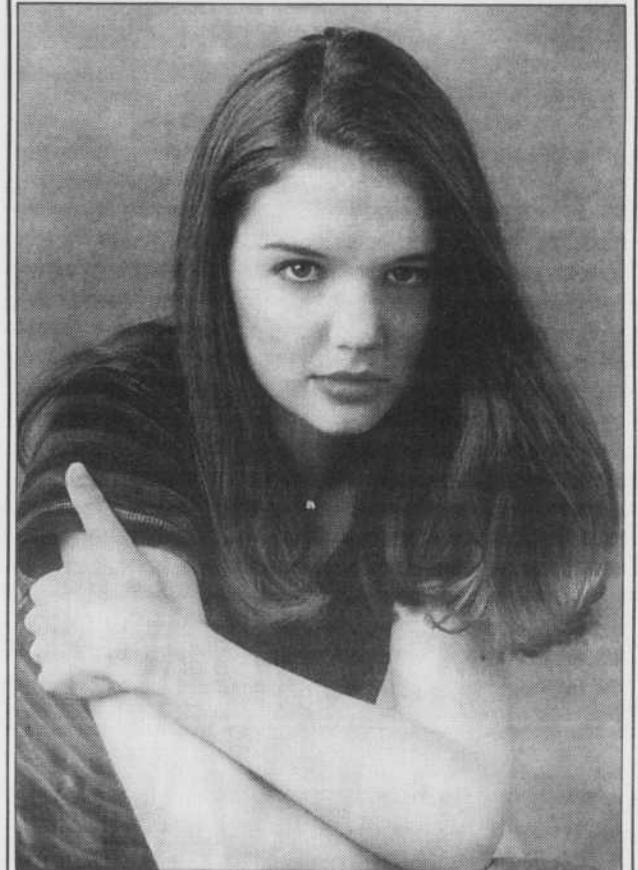

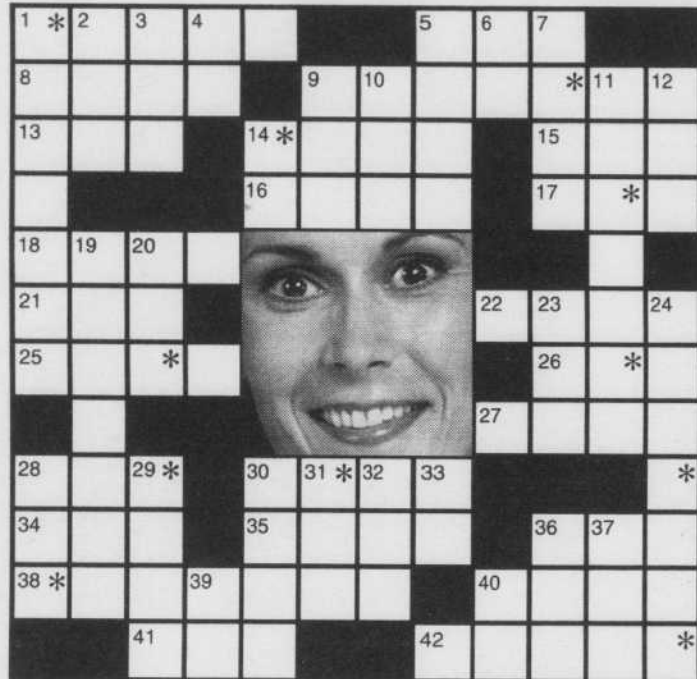
