



Trail Building Protocol – 2019

- Visit and advise all owners contiguous to trail building that we will be working on trails on property belonging to the Trust. To be done before work begins by at least one Board member.
- Share the plans and maps of trail work to be done in that season to confirm that we are not encroaching onto a contiguous owner's land.
- Advise neighbours to contact Normand and Margot with any issues. Provide them with our phone numbers.
- Have Mahicans and Matthew introduce themselves to neighbours between our visit and commencement of work with at least one Board member present at this meeting.
- Approve Trail plans only after a physical visit by one or more Board members to confirm that trail route does not encroach on neighbour's privacy.
- Create necessary signage with rules. Create signs that speak directly to the issue of dogs off leash. Signs would explain why this is not permitted.
- Confirm that biologists at Corridor Appalachien have approved the trail route for conservation compliance. (This protocol has been in place since Year 1)
- Have all employees carry identification that they are employed by the Trust.
- Have Mahicans and members of his team direct any complaints to us by explaining that they cannot speak on behalf of the Board.
